Team Teague Player/Coach Gear and Travel Expectations

1. There will be **NO** Player team fees unless you play with an alternate team anytime between March-July \$200.00
2. All team will receive Uniforms, Bags & Shooting Shirt. Parents will provide shoes. We will be able to get discounted shoes at the parents cost.
3. Turf Training (Strength & Conditioning) will be provided 1 time per week.
4. Vertimax Training will be provided 2 times per week.
5. Joey Burton: Shooting Coach team training 1 time bi-Weekly per team.
6. We pay all tournament fees.
7. We pay for team Van transport outside of 3.0 hours radius from home teams location.
8. We pay for coaches hotels for duration of event on travel tournaments outside of 3-hour radius of home teams.
9. Hotels are provided for Head Coaches and 2nd room to be shared with assistant Coach and any players who may be traveling without parents or designated adult.
10. Coaches understand that they are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times while associating themselves with the Team Teague Program. All coaches must also complete a criminal history background check before season begins. Appropriately Coaching, mentoring and fathering our young men is an expectation we don't take likely and is a very high expectation for all coaches.
11. AAU SEASON starts officially for Team Teague March 1st through July 31st. We will put teams in Leagues and holiday local tournaments beginning November 1st. Reminder – all players that are members of this team must honor the rule of playing only with Team Teague between March 1st – through July 31st or your last scheduled tournament unless playing for your school team. If this rule is broken, player will be charged \$200.00 to be reinstated to the team.
